

# Volunteer Engagement for American Indian and Alaska Native Missing Persons Cases

The International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) is working with the COPS Office and Operation Lady Justice—the Presidential Task Force on Missing and Murdered American Indians and Alaska Natives—to develop a training focused on volunteer programs in tribal law enforcement agencies. This training will support tribal agencies in starting and managing a volunteer program to support missing persons cases. Building upon the IACP's Volunteers in Police Service curriculum, this training will include a four-hour workshop geared toward tribal leadership and an eight-hour training for tribal law enforcement and other staff who will develop the program and manage volunteers.
